Updated Timeline

2007

July 12 AgLime receives a zoning permit for an agricultural building (no accurate description of project)

2008

May 29 AgLime files a detailed application to DEP for a municipal waste permit

July 12 AgLime's 2007 zoning permit expires

July 24 LMIP (Local Municipal Involvement Process) Meeting on the Proposed AgLime Biosolids Processing Facility (required for DEP approval)

2009

Jan. 11 Daryl Beiler submits a new application for a zoning permit

Jan. 12 Daryl Beiler submits a new Land Development Plan (showing a building the same size and footprint as in application to DEP) for zoning approval.

Mar. 3 DEP denies AgLime application (submitted in 2008) due to technical deficiencies

Apr. 23 Buffalo Twp. Zoning Officer **denies** zoning permit because proposed use does not comply with zoning requirements for agricultural land

Apr. 27 Buffalo Twp. Planning Commission **denies** zoning application.

May 20 Daryl Beiler appeals the Buffalo Twp. Zoning Officer's denial to Buffalo Township Zoning Hearing Board

July 14 Buffalo Twp. Zoning Hearing Board **denies** appeal of zoning officer's denial of a zoning permit.

Aug.2 Daryl Beiler appeals the Buffalo Twp. Hearing Board denial to the Court of Common Pleas

2010

Jan 11 Daryl Beiler submits another Land Development Application for a proposed agricultural building (once again 56,520')

Feb 2 Buffalo Twp. Zoning Officer **denies** zoning permit (proposed use not agricultural)

Mar. 29 Daryl Beiler appeals the Zoning Officer's decision.

Apr. 21 Buffalo Twp. Zoning Hearing Board **denies** appeal of Zoning Officer's denial of zoning permit.

July 2 Daryl Beiler appeals the Zoning Hearing Board denial

Nov.1 Hearing in the Court of Common Pleas on the 2009 appeals.

2011

- Jan. 20 The Litigation Section of the Office of the Attorney General informs the Buffalo Township Supervisors that they received a request from Daryl and Gina Beiler to review the township's zoning ordinance in order to determine if it unlawfully limits or restricts a normal agricultural operation. Review must be completed in 120 days.
- Feb. 15 Court of Common Pleas **denies** Daryl and Gina Beiler's appeals of the township's 2009 decisions and upholds the decisions of the township's zoning officer and the Zoning Hearing Board.
- March 17 Daryl and Gina Beiler appeal the decision of the Court of Common Pleas. The appeal will be heard in the Commonwealth Court. No date has been set.

No date has been set to hear the appeals of the 2010 zoning and Hearing Board decisions.
